- Set annual goals for the worship ministry that are in line with our Vision Culture
- Develop yourself and others by continually working on your craft and encouraging others
- Build relationships that foster team chemistry with congregation and volunteers
- Receive and welcome visitors
- Answer and respond to email and phone contacts
- Maintain personal calendar
- Willingness to perform other duties as assigned
